Social Science: Standard B.4.2 By the end of Grade 4 HISTORY: Time, Continuity, and Change

Content Standard

Students in Wisconsin will learn about the history of Wisconsin, the United States, and the world, examining change and continuity over time in order to develop historical perspective, explain historical relationships, and analyze issues that affect the present and the future.

Standard B.4.2

Use a timeline to select, organize, and sequence information describing eras in history

Activity: Students will organize six dates and place them on a timeline. They will then use an image to represent each featured date to gain a better understanding of the event.

Directions: Identify, and reorganize the following 6 dates on a timeline, and draw an icon or image to represent each date

*Milwaukee was home to the second ever performance of a full German Opera. Milwaukee Musical Society performed Albert Lortzing's famous Czar and Zimmerman in 1853.

*In 1925 the Polish Opera Club featured a production of Halka as the first motion picture to be filmed entirely in Wisconsin.

*Michael L. Nemmers settled in Milwaukee in 1885 and is considered a pioneer composer of Catholic Church music in the United States.

*A woman's musical organization known as the Macdowell Club was created in Milwaukee in 1911.

*In 1856 the first regional festival was held in Milwaukee known as the Singer Festival.

*Mozart Hall built in 1847 was the first theater to focus on music, and was seen as the birthplace for the Milwaukee Musical Society.
